Dear Charlotte County Campers,

1. Our doors open at 10 am and are locked at 5 pm. No one is allowed on the property between the hours of 5 pm and 8 am.
2. Anyone caught or photographed possessing, using, passing or selling drugs will be immediately trespassed by the police.
3. Daily shower schedule for Single adults w/o children Monday through Friday: 10 to 12:30. Due to so many newly homeless folks, we must limit you to 5 minutes to get clothes; 10 minute-showers.
***There will be 15 minutes of community service clean-up around the building before showers.
4. Daily shower schedule for families w/children and those getting off work or going to work: 3-4:30. We are low on smaller size men's clothing – so we ask you exchange your jeans/shorts after 1 free set of clothes per week.
5. Lunch: Monday through Friday: sandwiches are put out by 11:00 along with yogurt (if we have it)

2nd Sunday – March 12th: 1 to 3 pm Jesus Loves You Ministry at 1734 Cedarwood St., Port Charlotte. We'll serve lunch, have clothing, showers, haircuts and prayer. Pick up in Punta Gorda at 12:15; Bayshore Pavillion at 12:30. No pick up at northern camps because you can ride your bikes.

3rd Sunday – March 19th: 1 to 3 pm Jesus Loves You Ministry at 1734 Cedarwood St., Port Charlotte. For the homeless only. We'll serve lunch, have clothing, showers, haircuts and prayer. Pick up in Punta Gorda at 12:15; Bayshore Pavillion at 12:30.

4th Sunday – March 26th: 1pm to 3pm New Day Christian Church at 20212 Peachland Blvd. They serve lunch, clothes and hair-cuts. *Their van picks up at Bayshore Park, Doggie Park Bayshore Rd. & Homeless Coalition anywhere between 12:15 and 12:45.

 **Every Tuesday:** Soup & sandwich bags & TP are brought beginning at 11:00 am to the following locations in this order: Bayshore Park, BP Station on Hy41 & Easy St., Park behind YMCA on Quesada, 7th Day Church on Barrett, Freedom Bible Church on Sable St. & the Jesus Loves You
NOTE: The last Tuesday, January 31st, we bring non-perishable food bags and hygiene bags.
